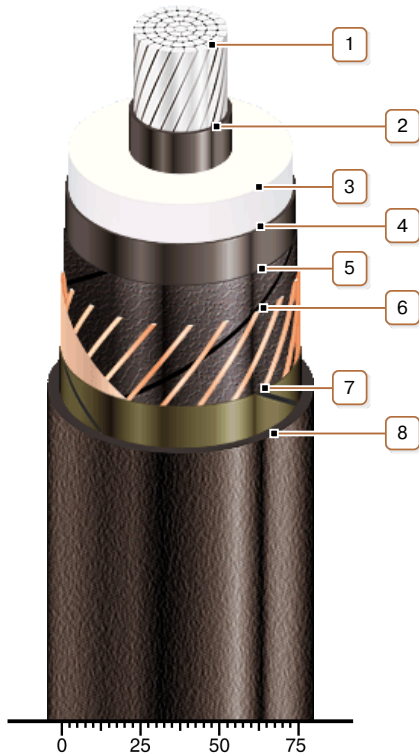

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CONSTRUCTION

1. Aluminium multiwire compacted conductor

Note: It is possible to manufacture cable with sealed conductor.

2. Inner extruded semiconducting layer

3. XLPE insulation

4. Outer extruded semiconducting layer

5. Lapping layer of semiconductive swellable tape

6. Copper screen

Note: It is possible to manufacture a cable with a fiber optic module built into the screen, including as a DTS system sensor

7. Lapping layer of glass tape

8. Low flammable PVC compound outer sheath
