CONSTRUCTION

1. Aluminium multiwire compacted conductor

- It is possible to manufacture cable with a single-wire conductor
- · It is possible to manufacture cable with sealed conductors.
- 2. Inner extruded semiconducting layer
- 3. XLPE insulation
- 4. Outer extruded semiconducting layer
- 5. Lapping layer of semiconductive swellable tape
- 6. Copper screen
- 7. Extruded filling of PVC compound
- 8. Strengthened polyethylene outer sheath

Note: It is possible to manufacture cable with extruded semiconductor layer along outer sheath
